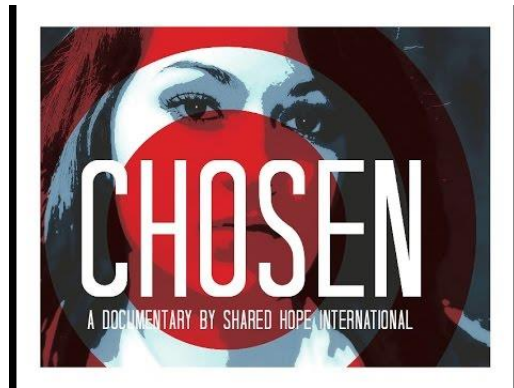

Join us to Take Back the Night with an empowerment demonstration, gathering and speakers in solidarity with all victims/survivors of sexual violence.

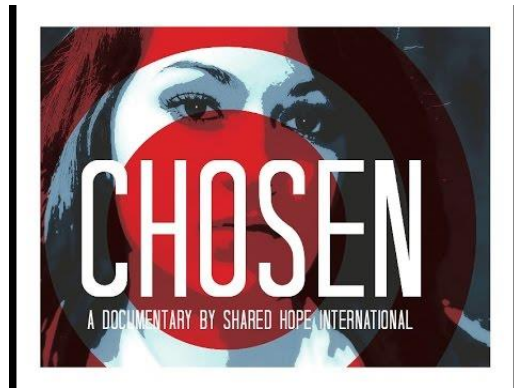
- 5 p.m. Assemble at Itasca Community College in the Wenger Hall field to create signs, or bring your own
